



IN REMEMBRANCE



Group buries America's unclaimed veterans, one soldier at a time



http://www.foxnews.com/us/2013/12/10/group-buries-america-unclaimed-veterans-one-soldier-at-time/ Launched nationwide in early 2007, the Missing in America Project has visited more than 1,400 funeral homes to date across the country in search of unidentified, unclaimed remains. In all, 6,924 cremated remains have been found and 1,929 veterans have been identified. Of those, 1,791 have been interred by the group. "We've found people who have been on the shelves for a hundred years," he said. "Those were harder to identify of course, but we did find them, prove them and buried them."

To provide that final resting place brings "immense satisfaction, there's camaraderie there, they're a fellow veteran. It's a mission of the heart."
