

Best of all, he wasn't paying a dime for the trip, which would take him from Green Valley to Atlanta, across the Atlantic to the United Kingdom, from there to Dubai and finally to Japan. But, in route to Georgia, a call came out on the plane's PA system for Daniel Seibert to identify himself. When he did, a flight attendant asked him to wait on the plane after it landed. Seibert's experience is becoming unnervingly more common. ICE and U.S. Customs and Border Protection have seen a growing trend of such scam victims being used to take mainly illegal narcotics - across international borders.



Richard Lee (Dick) Hott, 17-year resident of Heritage Harbour in Annapolis, Md., died December 12 at Anne Arundel Medical Center after a long period of declining health. Born May 10, 1927, to Atlee and Marie Hott, he was raised in Paw Paw, W.Va. Dick enlisted in World War II at 17 and served in Guam and Bikini Atoll with

the 53rd Navy Seabees as a carpenter. Dick and Jacky lived as newlyweds and young parents in Cumberland and Paw Paw before moving to Washington, D.C. He worked as a building contractor and as a window sales representative, but always considered himself a carpenter. He leaves a legacy of fine woodworking in his home and with loved ones. Museum Advisory Council Green-lights 75th Seabee Anniversary Plans for March 2017 PORT HUENEME, Calif. -Plans to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the creation of the U.S. Navy Seabees as well as the 150th anniversaries of the Civil Engineer Corps (CEC) in March 2017 are now underway at the U.S. Navy Seabee Museum.

"It is important to share this information with the people in our community," Godbille explained. "We have a responsibility to tell the Seabee/CEC story with dignity and respect."

The second oldest of the official Navy museums, the Seabee Museum was established in 1947 in Port Hueneme, Calif. which today is part of Naval Base Ventura County (NBVC).

Leroy Gresham, 94, March 20, 1921 - January 23, 2016

Leroy Gresham, 94, of Harris County spent most of his time as a Seabee in the Marine Corps when he fought his way from New Caledonia to Guadalcanal. From there, Gresham said he went to Bougainville before returning back to Guadalcanal, the scene of some of the most intense fighting during World War II. The Battle of Guadalcanal was the first major offensive by Allied forces against the Empire of Japan. "We just went and people died." "I was one of the fortunate ones. We were the Marine Corps."
