



Preliminary work has begun on holding the reunion in the Arlington, Virginia area. Assisting Jason and Mary will be Jim and Wendy Donohue.









Oregon veteran, 95, beats coronavirus: 'I survived Guam, I can get through this bulls—t' MCMINNVILLE, Ore. (KGW) — "We slept in foxholes," said Kelly, recalling his time in World War II serving with the 53rd Naval Construction Battalion.

Last month, Kelly fought a different kind of world war—"We're being attacked by a virus," he said—and won. "I was fortunate, really fortunate," Kelly said. "I pray a lot too!"

"I couldn't believe I had it," Kelly said, "because I was pretty much at home all the time." Kelly spent the next two weeks isolated in his room at his family's home in McMinnville, Oregon. "I had a little cabin fever," Kelly said. "I wanted to be out with the troops!" Kelly's two great-grandsons in particular. He said one of them would occasionally break the quarantine rules. "My little 5-year-old, once in a while he'd come in there and sneak me some candy and sneak back out again," Kelly said. No one was quite sure how Kelly contracted COVID-19, and no one else in his home got sick. "We are very fortunate to live in the United States, and we got everything going for us," Kelly said. "Just do what's right and do what we're told, and everything will be OK." nypost.com
