Tom & Pat Shannon have locked in our rooms at the Holiday Inn, downtown Duluth MN.

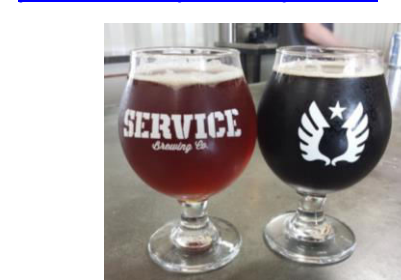

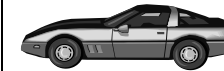

A former Fort Carson soldier turned his hobby into a Savannah, Ga., brewery pumping out military-themed beers that are the toast of the Pentagon.

Kevin Ryan, who served in Iraq as a Captain for Carson's 3rd Brigade Combat Team, opened Service Brewing Co. last year and has brewed up selections that include Ground Pounder Ale and Rally Point Pilsner. "My girlfriend bought me a homebrewing kit three years ago for Valentine's Day." Ryan credits the Army for his brewing success, saying eight years in uniform taught him lessons that helped not only on the battlefields of central Iraq but also at his brewery. The cooler for his tasting room is a nod to conditions at Balad (a place then dubbed "Mortaritaville"): a shipping container.

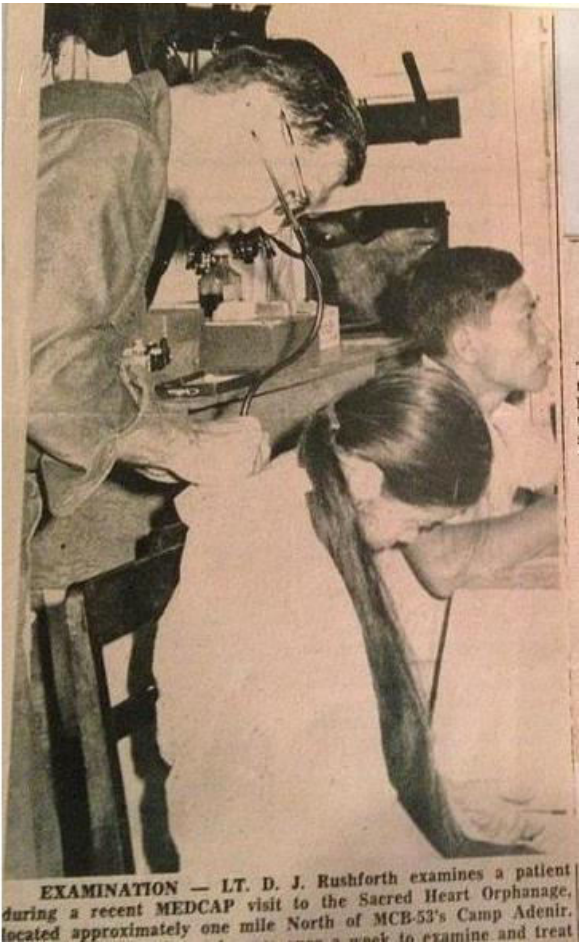

David Jenks Rushforth, M.D fulfilled so many roles. Loving and devoted husband to Jan for 42 years, amazing and selfless father . A nature lover, Dave nourished the local birds through the New England winters, always walking the edge of the porch carefully so as not to disturb the beautiful carpet of fresh-fallen snow, which was the foreground of his magnificent view of his cherished Eel River. He famously implemented this environmentalism as a Plymouth Selectman to save "Swan-zilla" in 2003. His life long passion to "get it right" came much to the chagrin of his fellow board members, who were each given research packets several inches thick each Sunday before meetings. "Dr. Dave", hunting pheasant with his beloved German Shorthair Pointer Rommel, and surf casting at dawn. Always one to help others, Dave was known to open the back door of the radiology department to those to couldn't afford to come through the front. (Dave was so touched when a local fisherman thanked him with lobster.) This same passion lead him to use his "free time" while serving as a Navy medic in Vietnam to aide the local children and village T.B. clinic.
