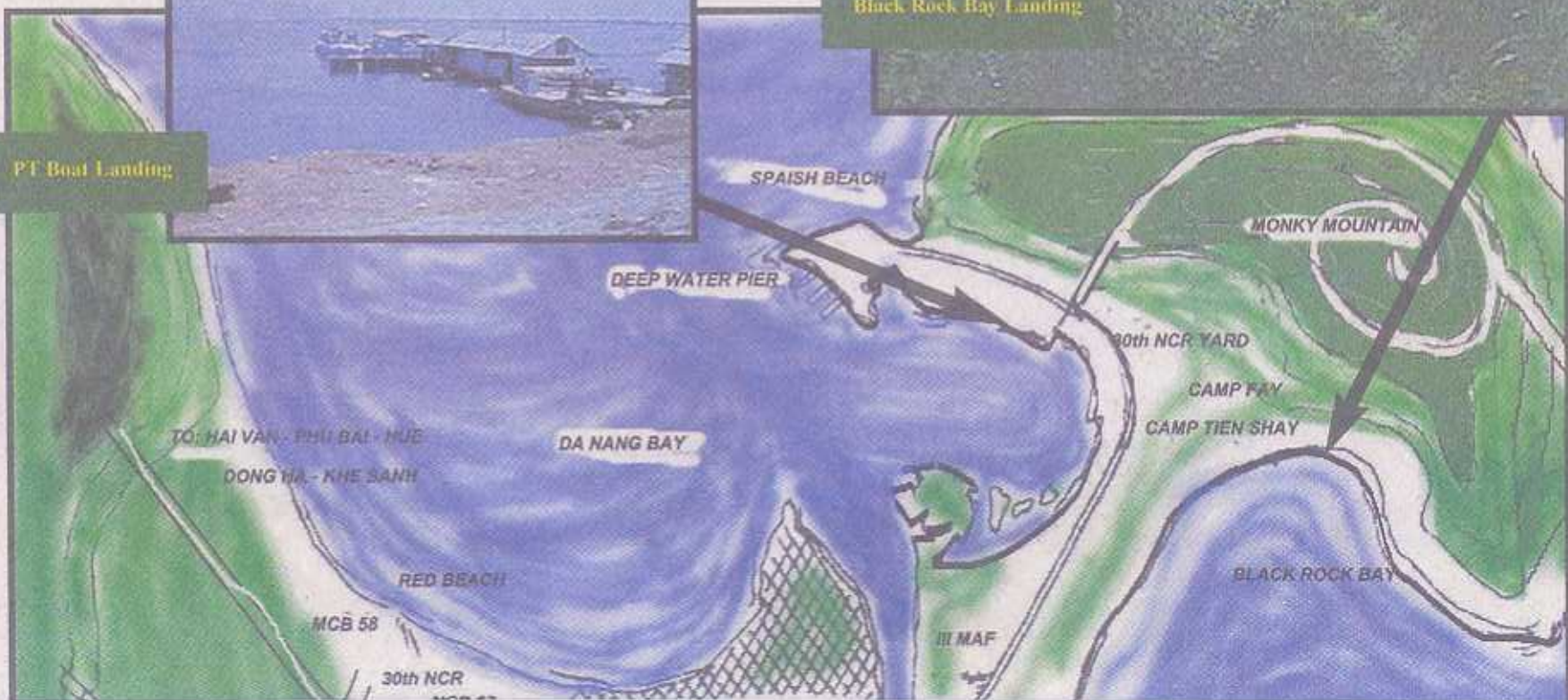

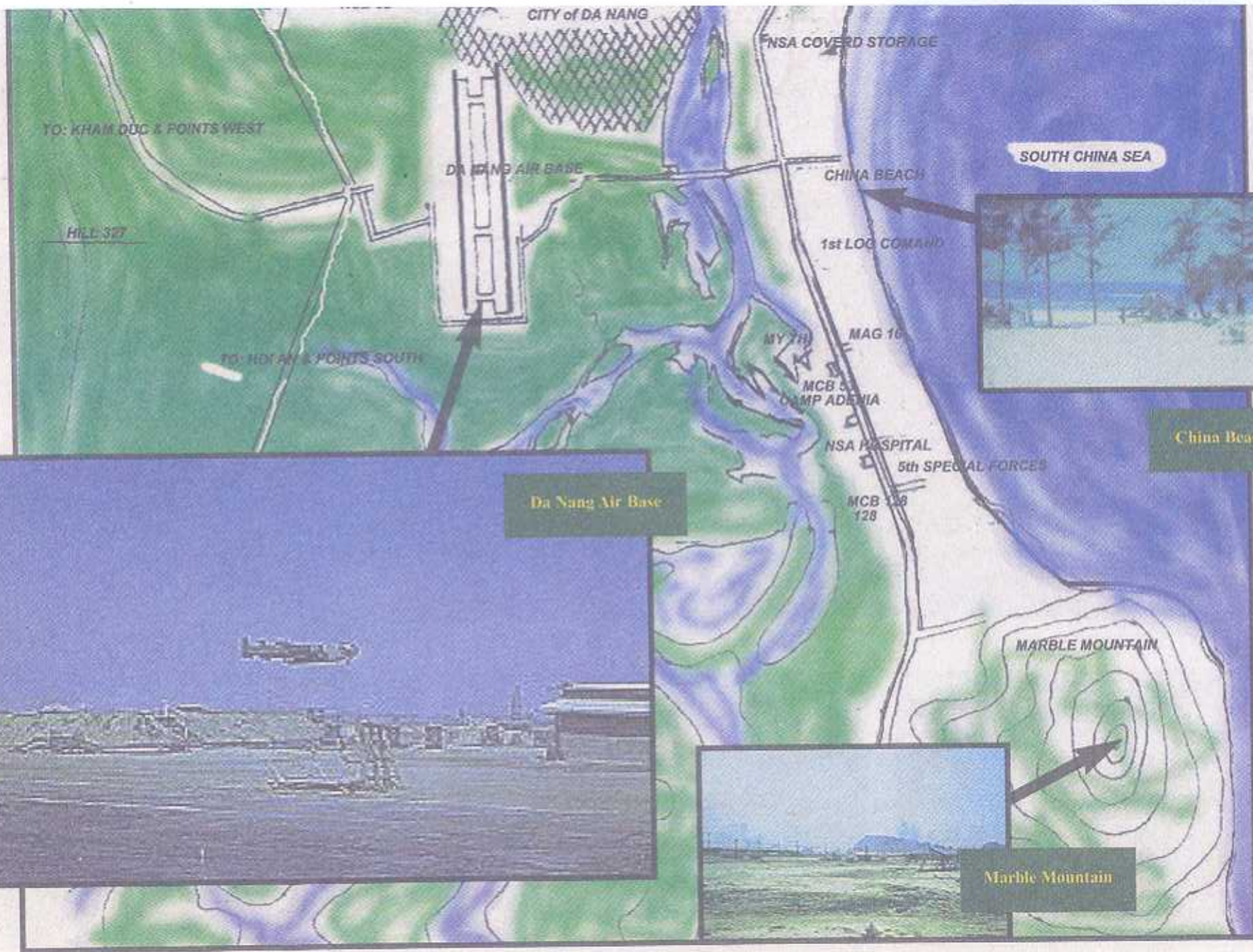

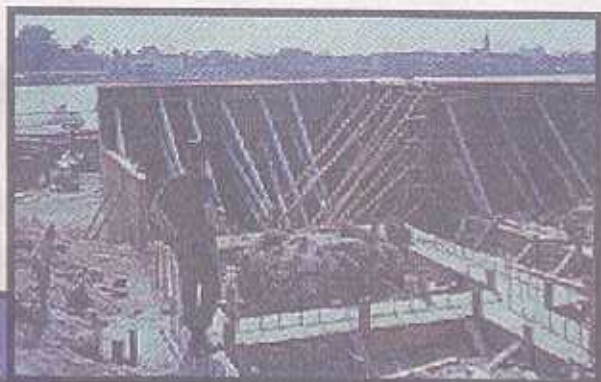
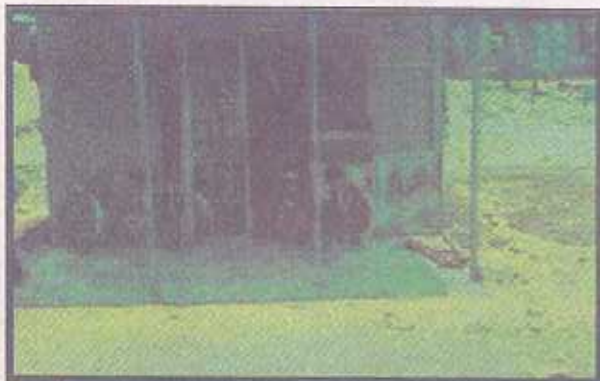




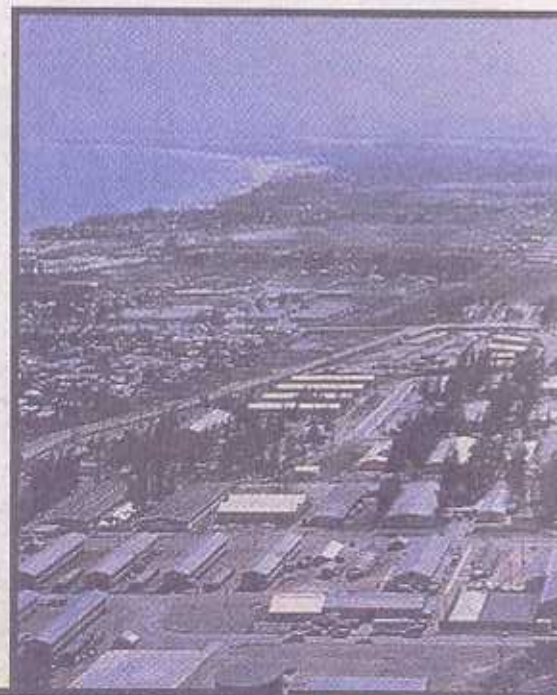
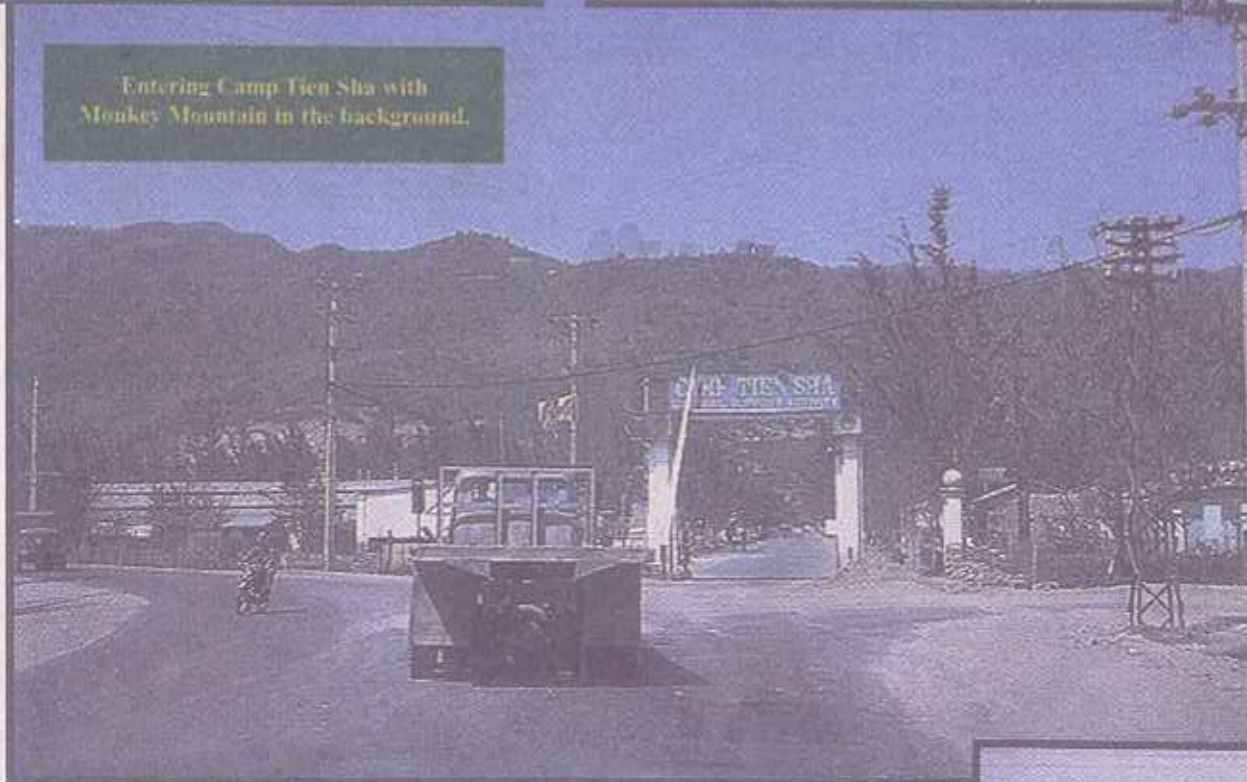

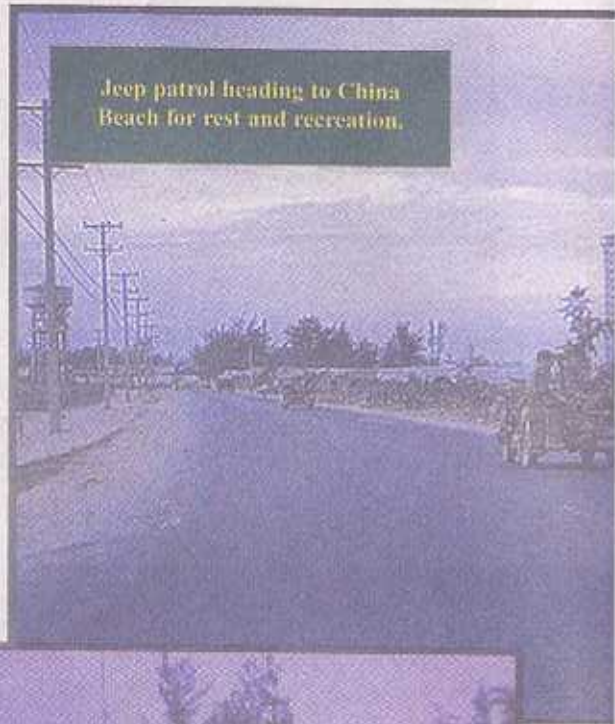

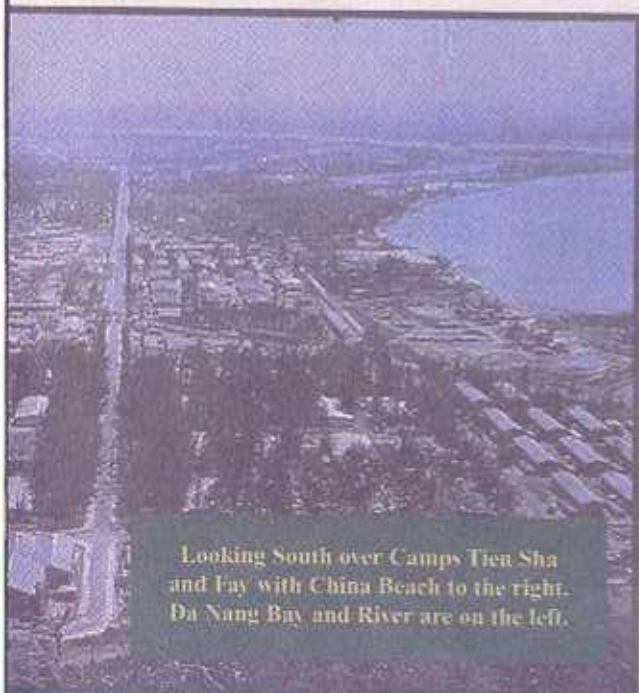

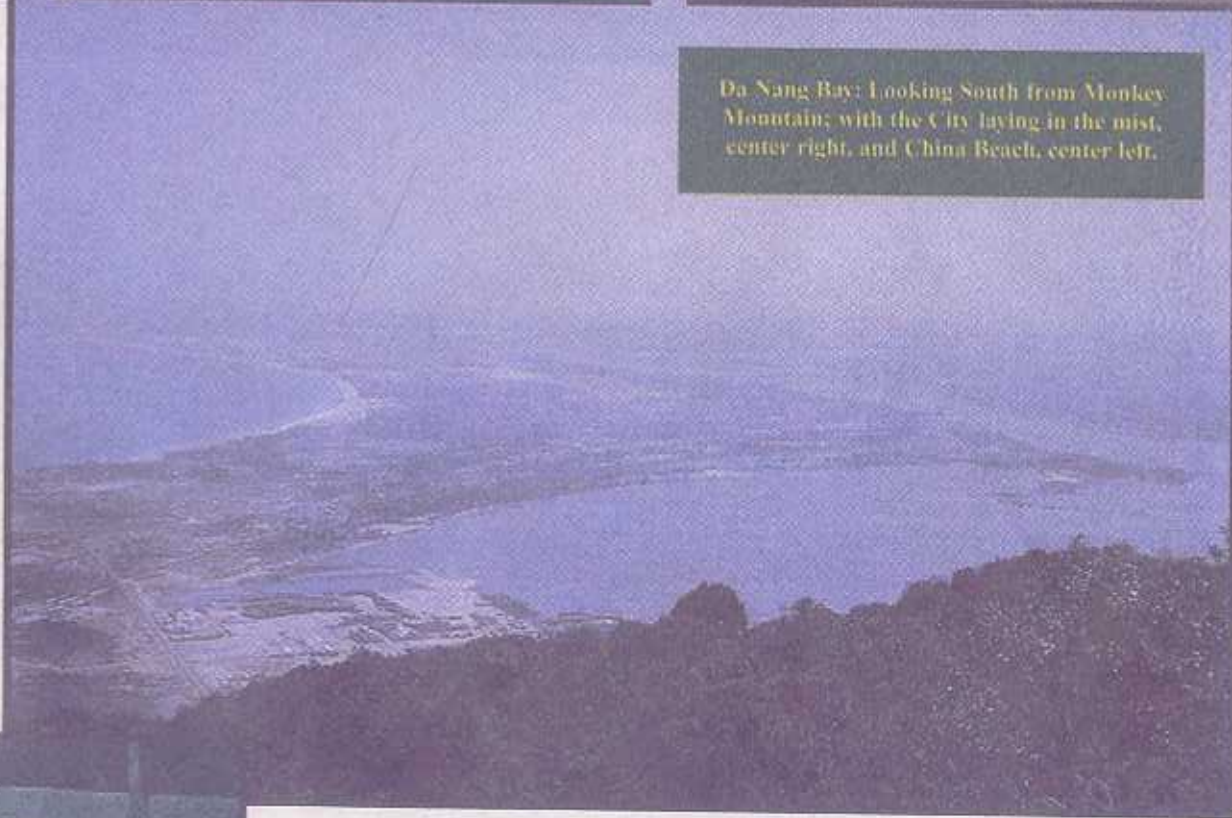


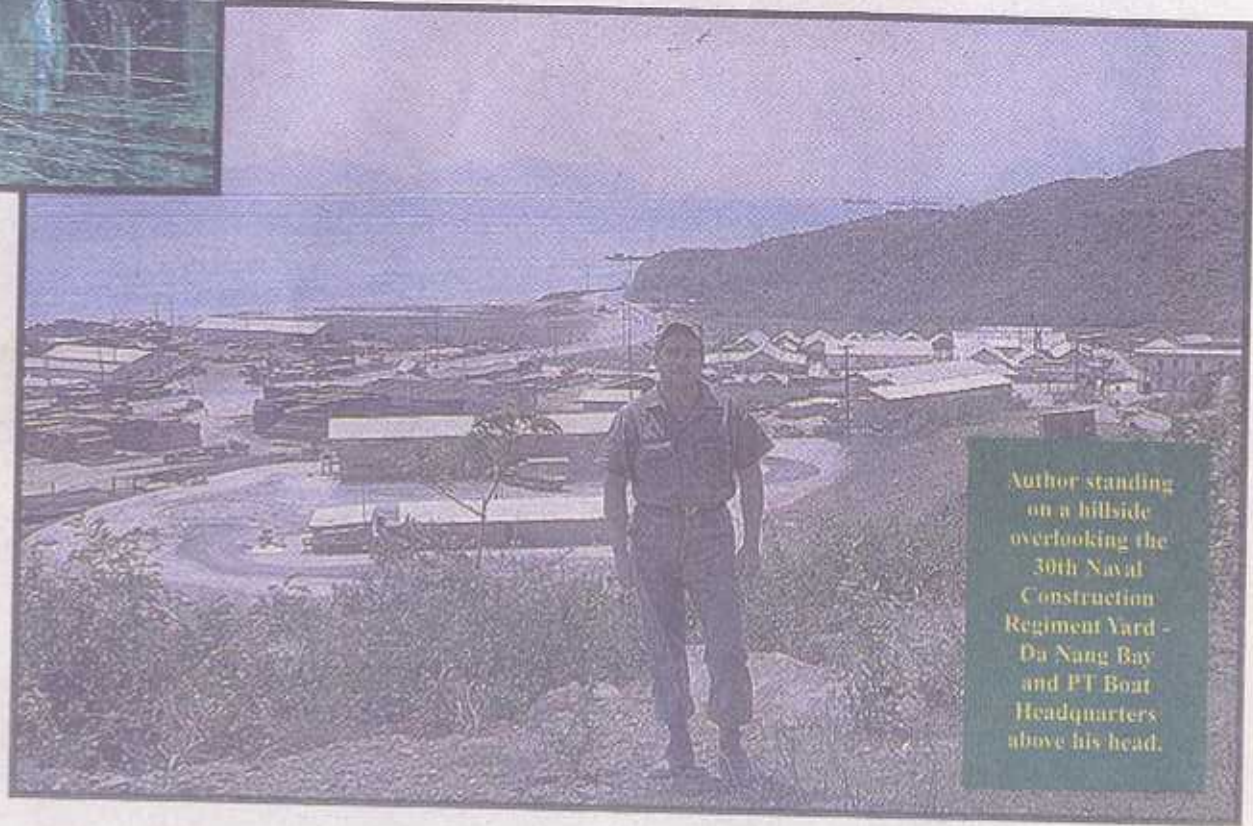
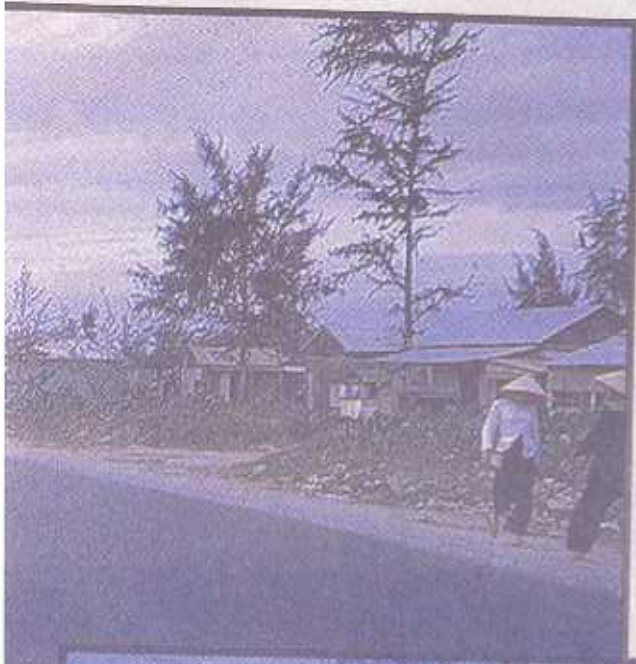


Da Nang Bay: Looking South from Monkey Mountain; with the City laying in the mist, center right, and China Beach, center left.
